For larger projects 20, 30 and 40 yard drop box service is available. Please call 360-892-4522 for rates and details.

SERVICE CANCELLATION

You may sign up for or cancel yard debris service at any time. If you choose to cancel and restart collection service within a year of cancellation, a restart/redelivery fee may be assessed. Consider going "on-call" instead of cancelling your service during the winter. You will pay a small rental fee and a pick up fee whenever you use the service. You must notify customer service at least 24 hours in advance to guarantee an "on-call" pick up.

Here is a handy guide to your yard debris service!
Please note your service day and frequency below.

YES WHAT GOES IN?

Leaves, weeds, prunings, grass clippings, brush and woody material up to four inches in diameter and under five feet in length.



NO WHAT STAYS OUT?



NO food, household or hazardous waste, vegetables, paper or plastic bags, dirt, sod, rocks, pet waste, or branches over 4 inches in diameter or over 5 feet in length.

WEIGHT LIMITS

The maximum allowed weight is 130 pounds for 64-gallon carts, and 200 pounds for 90-96 gallon carts. Overweight carts cannot be emptied by our equipment.

CART PLACEMENT

Please make sure your cart is no farther than five feet from the curb, set out by 6:00 AM on your service day. The front of the cart must face the street. Also, keep in mind that the cart will need to be 5 feet from mailboxes, recycle bins and garbage cans and also 5 feet from automobiles, recreational vehicles and basketball hoops.



FALL PUMPKINS & HOLIDAY TREES

In October and November, pumpkins* are accepted in the yard debris cart. When placing pumpkins in the cart, please observe the weight limits. In

December and January, you can include one tree in your cart. Please do not put any tree section longer than 5 feet in your cart. Flocked trees and trees with tinsel or other decorations cannot be accepted.

**Sorry, pumpkins are not accepted in yard debris carts in Camas and Washougal.*

EXTRAS

For an additional charge, extra yard debris may be placed at the curb in bags, cans and/or bundles. Please follow these guidelines when setting out extra yard debris:

BAGS: Compostable, double walled kraft bags, less than 40 pounds

CANS: 32 gallon size or smaller, less than 75 pounds

BRUSH BUNDLES: Brush must be no more than one foot in diameter or five feet in length, tied with twine or string (no wire ties)

Loose piles of yard debris are not accepted.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Yard debris will not be collected on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day. If your service day falls on one of these holidays, collection will be made on the following day.

Your yard debris pickup schedule:

PICKUP DAY:

Monday Tuesday Wednesday Thursday Friday
