Clark County, the cities of Battle Ground, Camas, La Center, Ridgefield, Vancouver and Washougal and the town of Yacolt are hosting Recycling Day Events in 2016. The events give Clark County residents the opportunity to manage a variety of special wastes through reuse, recycling or safe disposal. **Household hazardous waste (HHW) is NOT accepted at these events.**

What is accepted?

A/C units, electronics, freezers, refrigerators, scrap metal, clean and dry block foam, and tires. Paper shredding also offered except at the Yacolt and Ridgefield locations. See the back of this flyer for more detailed information on what is accepted at the 2016 Recycling Day Events.

RECYCLING DAY EVENTS

MATERIALS ACCEPTED

Residential only. No business waste. Your local municipality may accept other materials at its event. Check with your city or town for site-specific info.

BLOCK FOAM

ACCEPTED: White #6 block foam (Styrofoam®), clean and dry.

NOT ACCEPTED: Plastic-wrapped, yellow urethane foam, spongy polypropylene foam, food trays, foam film, hot tub covers, packing peanuts and foam with cardboard with tape or metal attached.

E-WASTE

ACCEPTED: Computers, monitors, routers, printers, fax machines, typewriters, keyboards, TVs, VCRs, cell phones and other electronics such as toasters, coffee makers or hair dryers.

NOT ACCEPTED: Microwaves.

FREON CONTAINING ITEMS

ACCEPTED: Residential freezers, refrigerators and A/C units only; limit three Freon containing units per participant/per day.

NOT ACCEPTED: Commercial equipment or RV and automotive air conditioning units.

SCRAP METAL

ACCEPTED: Large appliances (such as stoves, hot water heaters, washers/dryers, dishwashers), barbecues, metal sinks and similar metal items. Items must be mostly metal.

NOT ACCEPTED: Propane tanks, car bodies, trailers or metals with grease.

SHREDDING

ACCEPTED: Limit of two banker boxes per visit. **(Available at specific locations only)**

TIRES

ACCEPTED: Regular size automobile, SUV, pickup truck and motorcycle tires; limit five tires per participant/per day. Rims off tires are accepted as scrap metal.

NOT ACCEPTED: Tractor-trailer size or larger, **tires with rims**, tires from service station owners, repair garages or any type of tire dealer or re-treader.

Recycling Day Events are a cooperative effort among Clark County and Battle Ground, Camas, La Center, Ridgefield, Vancouver, Washougal and Yacolt with grant funding from the Washington State Department of Ecology. These events are open to all Clark County residents. Proof of residency, such as identification with address, may be required.

Dispose of household chemicals, paints, poisons, automotive fluids & pesticides for free at transfer stations

Household hazardous waste includes:

Automotive Products: oil, antifreeze, gasoline, brake and transmission fluid

Household Cleaners: oven cleaners, drain cleaners, disinfectants, laundry products

Paints and Solvents: latex and oil base paint, thinners, varnishes, wood preservatives

Poisons/Pesticides: fungicides, insecticides, herbicides and rodenticides.
