

# RECYCLING DONE RIGHT

Please have all containers set out by the curb no later than 6:00 am

## in the cart



### Mixed Recycling

#### PAPER & CARDBOARD



Newspaper, magazines, junk mail, phone books, paper bags, cereal boxes, gift and shoe boxes, writing and printing paper  
 Shredded paper – contain in brown paper bag  
 Milk cartons, drink boxes, soy milk and soup boxes – rinse  
 Cardboard – flatten and cut down to fit inside cart

#### METAL



Aerosol cans – empty cans only; remove lids  
 Aluminum and tin cans – rinse  
 Scrap metal – less than 35 pounds; no larger than 24 inches in any dimension; remove any attached plastic, rubber, or wood

**WHEN IN DOUBT, LEAVE IT OUT!**

#### PLASTIC BOTTLES & TUBS



Plastic bottles – rinse  
 Plastic tubs – rinse and remove lids  
 Plastic buckets – 5 gallons or less  
 Nursery pots – empty; free of dirt

### Glass

#### GLASS BOTTLES & JARS



– rinse and remove lids

### Motor Oil, Antifreeze & Batteries

#### MOTOR OIL & ANTIFREEZE

Set out in a clear, one-gallon plastic jug with a screw-top lid. Do NOT mix motor oil or antifreeze with each other or with any other material (no water, brake fluid, solvents, etc)

#### BATTERIES

Put batteries in a sealed clear plastic bag on top of the cart

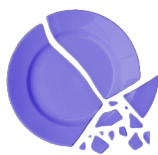

##### Poisons/Pesticides:

Fungicides, insecticides, herbicides and rodenticides
