LARGE PROJECT?

For large projects 20, 30 and 40 yard drop box services are available. Please call 360-892-4522 for rates and details.

You may sign up for or cancel yard debris service at any time. If you choose to cancel and restart collection service within a year of cancellation, a restart/redelivery fee may be assessed. Consider going "on-call" instead of canceling your service during the winter. You will pay a small rental fee and a pick up fee whenever you use the service. You must notify customer service at least 24 business hours in advance to guarantee an "on-call" pick up.

YARD DEBRIS GUIDE

We accept:

brush leaves weeds branches* grass clippings



Please no:

food, fruit or vegetables, household or hazardous waste, paper or plastic bags, dirt, sod, rocks, pet waste, construction debris, sawdust, barkdust, or branches over 4 inches in diameter and 5 feet in length

Extras

For an additional charge, extra yard debris may be placed at the curb in bags, cans, and/or bundles. Please follow these quidelines:

BAGS: Compostable, double-walled kraft bags, less than 40 lbs

CANS: 32 gallon or smaller, less than 75 lbs

BRUSH BUNDLES: Brush must be no more than 1 foot in diameter or 5 feet in length, tied with twine or string (no wire ties)

Loose piles of yard debris are not accepted

Overweight carts cannot be emptied by our trucks. The maximum allowed weights are:

64 gal: 130 pounds90-96 gal: 200 pounds

Holiday Yard Debris

Pumpkins are accepted in the yard debris cart[†] in October and November. One tree can be placed in the cart in December and January. No decorations allowed and please follow the height and weight restrictions.

†Pumpkins are not accepted in vard debris carts in Camas and Washougal

Please Note! Drivers do not work on Thanksgiving, Christmas or New Year's Day. If your pick-up day is on or after one of these holidays, your service will be delayed by one day.
