# Let's Recycle Right!

#### **Keep Plastic Bags and Wrap OUT of Recycle Carts**

Recycle carts are regularly checked to make sure garbage isn't mixed in with clean recyclables. Plastic bags, stretchy film and plastic wrap frequently damage our recycling system. They get tangled up in machinery causing daily shutdowns for workers to cut them out by hand.

#### **Glass Recycling**

Only recycle bottles and jars that once held food or a liquid.




Glass must be loose in the glass recycle cart. No plastic bags, paper drink carriers or paper bags.

NO: lightbulbs, candles, broken glass, canning jars, drinking glasses, ceramics, windows, mirrors, tabletop glass, aquarium glass or bottles with fruit slices.

### 2022-23 Reference Guide

#### **Service Day Reminders**

- Set out all containers at the curb by 6:30 AM, unless otherwise advised
- Place containers 3 feet apart and 5 feet from obstacles (i.e., cars, trees, basketball hoops) for truck access

#### **Recycling Done Right**

- Recyclables should be empty, clean and dry
- Place items loose in the cart, do not bag
- No glass or objects that are sharp or heavy
- When in doubt, leave it out!











# **Motor Oil, Antifreeze and Batteries**

We accept motor oil, antifreeze and household batteries at the curb on your recycle service day.\* Find drop-off locations using **RecycleRight** app or at **wcnorthwest.com** 

#### **Motor Oil and Antifreeze**



- Pour motor oil or antifreeze into a clear, 1-gallon plastic jug with a screw-top lid.
- Label jug contents with 'motor oil' or 'antifreeze.'
- Place on the ground next to the recycle cart.
- NO: Mixing motor oil or antifreeze with each other or any other liquid, material, etc.
- NO: Pouring into other containers. Drivers will only pick up when stored in a 1-gallon plastic jug with a screw-top lid.



#### **Household Batteries**



- Tape the ends and put household batteries in a sealed, clear plastic bag.
- Place on top of your recycle cart.
- YES: Alkaline and rechargeable AA, AAA, C,
  D, button cell, 9 volt and other similar sized batteries
- NO: lithium-ion batteries (i.e., batteries from cell phones, laptops, tablets, power tools)



FIRE RISK: Lithium-ion batteries can explode when heated or damaged. These types of batteries easily spark a fire in a truck or at the transfer station. Take to a drop-off location to dispose of properly.

#### Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)











**FREE.** Bring HHW to a transfer station during designated HHW hours (noted above) for proper disposal.

To identify HHW, look for words on the product label such as caution, warning, danger, explosive, flammable, toxic or poison. HHW should NEVER be thrown in the trash or poured down the drain because it can pose threats to public health and the environment.



#### **Safe Medication Disposal**

FREE. Dispose of expired, unwanted or unused medicine safely and conveniently. Drop-off sites include Safeway, Albertsons, QFC and other pharmacies.

#### **Responsible Paint Recycling and Disposal**

FREE. Ensure cans or buckets of leftover paint are reused or properly disposed of:

#### **Extras**

Not enough space in your container? Set out extras, and find out more at wcnorthwest.com/extras

Put in a 32-gallon can or in a securely fastened garbage Garbage

bag. Charges apply.

Recycling Put in a 32-gallon can, cardboard box or paper bag.

No charge.

**NO:** Extra recycling in plastic bags or set out in the rain.


**Yard Debris** Put in 32-gallon can, kraft bag or in a tied bundle. **Organics** Charges apply.

**NO:** Yard debris in plastic bags or extra food scraps.



#### **Bulky Item Pickup at Home**

Schedule\* a bulky item pickup for items too large for your containers. Avoid a trip to the transfer station, and you may save time and money!

Live in the City of Vancouver? Customers can schedule FREE pickups

- 1 appliance: refrigerator, stove, washer, dryer
- Up to 5 bulky items: mattress, sofa, chair, table, dresser and other furniture



#### **Holiday Service**

There is no service on Thanksgiving. If your service day is on Thursday or Friday of this holiday week, your service will be delayed by one day. Thursday customers will be serviced on Friday, and Friday customers will be serviced on Saturday.

#### Postponed/Canceled Service


If road closures or unsafe conditions cause your service to be postponed or canceled you will be notified by an automated phone call. If service is canceled, we will reschedule or pick up a double load on your next service day. Here's what you can do to prepare:

- Sign up for service alerts through the RecycleRight app or wcnorthwest.com


Please note: Our automated phone message cannot reach you if your phone number is on the National Do Not Call Registry.

By separating out yard debris instead of putting it in the garbage, you are reducing what we landfill and helping to create nutrient-rich compost. You may even save money by reducing your garbage cart size or pickups.

#### **ENGLISH**

- Items should be empty, clean and dry.
- Place items loose in the cart. Do not bag items.
- No sharp or heavy objects.
