

Why RecyclePlus?

RecyclePlus is a convenient service that allows you to declutter your home and feel good about doing your part for the environment!

Schedule

RecyclePlus is an every-other-week service. We will inform you what your official pickup day will be.

Bags

Place items in the corresponding bags. Durable fabric bags are provided for textiles, light bulbs, batteries, and plastic film. Disposable bags will be provided as needed for block foam and clamshells.

Extras

If you have items that do not fit in the provided bags, we will still accept them! Extras can be placed in bags next to the RecyclePlus box. Set out extras 32-gallon bag. There is a maximum of 10 extra bags per pickup.

Placement & Service

On your service day, place your RecyclePlus box outside, near your door or a spot that's clearly visible from the road. The fabric bags will be emptied and returned to your box. Disposable bags with clamshells or block foam will be taken and you will receive another bag.

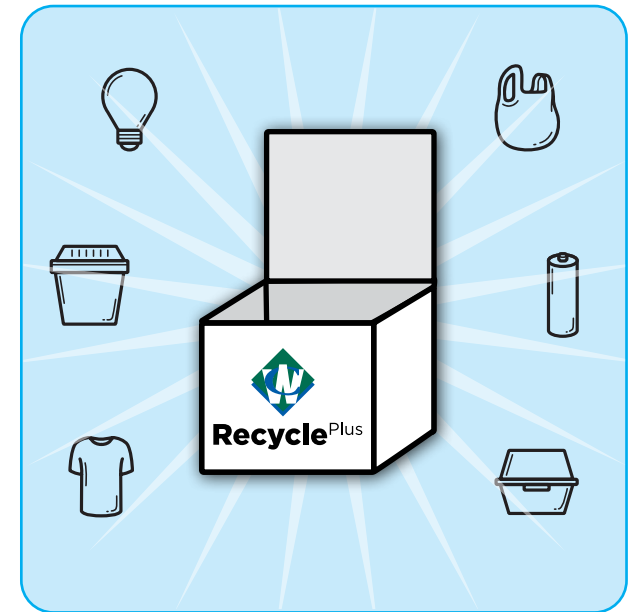

Light Bulbs



- Used and spent light bulbs
- Incandescent, halogen, CFL, LED

NO: Broken light bulbs



Textiles



- Clothing, shoes, accessories
- Bedding, fabric scraps 2"x 2" or larger

NO: Wet or mildewed items; fabric with oil, gasoline, or other hazardous materials



Clamshells



- Bakery, produce, to-go containers, etc.
- Clear PET/PETE (#1) only

NO: Food residue



Batteries



- Household batteries of all types and sizes
- Tape the ends of batteries to prevent sparks

NO: Vehicle batteries



Plastic Film



- Bags, overwrap, air pillows, etc.
- Stretchy plastic, not crinkly

NO: Food-soiled or dirty film plastic



Block Foam



- Coolers and other protective packaging
- White block foam (PS, #6) only

NO: Food residue, dirt, or tape
